Lesson outline	In this lesson the children will find out the author of the book we will be studying and the name of the book. They will make inferences by looking at the front cover. They will learn some key vocabulary and then read the first couple of paragraphs. All their ideas in this lesson are to be collected on a mind map.	In this lesson we will read the opening part of The Giant's Necklace. We will look to understand the main character's personality by analysing language and a conversation between the main character and her mother.	In this lesson we will read the next part of the story. We will focus on exploring character and looking at language.	In the lesson the children will read the next part of the story and form an impression of the setting. They will also make a prediction of what is going to happen next.	In the lesson the children will consider what part of the story they are up to. They will then read the next part of the story and consider whether their predictions were correct.
