We will end the lesson by considering what you can do to support conservation in your local area. We will learn about the outcomes or consequences of these threats on the biomes' flora and fauna, as well as the impact on us as humans. We will conclude the lesson by considering which of the three forest biomes is the most fragile and why.
