	Lesson outline	In this lesson, we will explore examples of genre in literature. We will explore the different kinds of reading we do each day and create a 24 hour reading log.	In this lesson, we explore how reading builds empathy. We will share recommended reads and explore character traits in order to describe a favourite character.	In this lesson, we will develop reading for pleasure through book recommendations. We will focus on nonfiction and picture books. Pupils will then generate their own recommendations to share with others.	In this lesson, we will recap what a verb is, define a simple sentence as a main clause that makes sense on its own and write our very own simple sentences. For this lesson, you will need an exercise book or some paper and a pencil..	In this lesson, we will explore the four word classes of nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs. We will consider their purpose and impact in writing and practise using them in our writing..
