	<b>Lesson outline</b>	<p>We will look at the success criteria again and remind ourselves what we need to include from the previous lesson. The next two paragraphs of the biography will be modelled in the shared write part of the lesson. The final paragraph, which is the conclusion, will be a modelled piece of writing, which we will analyse. Following the shared and modelled writes, children will have the opportunity to write their own paragraph.</p>	<p>In this lesson, children will review the function of apostrophes before identifying how apostrophes have been used in different examples</p>	<p>In this lesson, children review word class in a sentence before reviewing knowledge of subject, verb, and object. Following this, children practise identifying the subject, verb, and object in a sentence, before writing their own sentence and identifying the subject, verb, and object.</p>	<p>In this lesson, we will introduce new vocabulary, identify word pairs and synonyms, and apply the vocabulary in sentences.</p>	<p>In this lesson, we will practise using parentheses in the three forms (brackets, dashes and commas). Then we will explore why we use colons in writing and its uses. Each use will be looked at in more detail and then children will get to put their knowledge of the different uses into practice.</p>
