Key Vocabulary

Seasons	In places like the UK, there are four seasons each year. Autumn, winter, spring and summer.
Spring	In spring, the weather starts to get warmer. The leaves begin to grow on the tree and some trees may blossom. Plants begin to grow and baby animals are often born. Daytimes begin to get longer.  
Summer	In summer, the weather gets hotter. The daytime is long and the nights are short. The trees are full and you will often see lots of insects.
Weather	The weather includes the temperatures outside, wind direction and strength, as well as rain, cloud, snow and sun.
Daylight	Daylight is when it is light outside. The amount of day light changes with each season.

What is a season?

A season is each division of the year,. They link to weather patterns and daylight hours.

The four seasons are:
