Key Vocabulary

Seasons	There are four seasons each year, autumn, winter, spring and summer.
Autumn	In autumn, the weather begins to get colder. Daylight becomes less and leaves start to fall from the trees
Winter	Part of a plant which takes in in winter, the weather is much colder. Sometimes it snows and the trees are left bare. Daytimes are short and the night times are the longest.
Weather	The weather includes the temperatures outside, wind direction and strength, as well as rain, cloud, snow and sun.
Daylight	Daylight is when it is light outside. The amount of day light changes with each season.

What is a season?

A season is each division of the year,. They link to weather patterns and daylight hours.

The four seasons are:
