## **September 2020**

Yesterday the government published guidance for opening schools to all pupils from September 2020. We are still in the process of completing our risk assessment to ensure that everyone is safe in school and will get more details to you as soon as they are confirmed. The government has made it clear that **all pupils will have to return to school in September.**

## **PE Kit**

From September children **will need to wear their PE uniform to school all day** on the days they have PE. In September we will let you know the days your child will have PE. PE uniform is just as important as school uniform and we expect all children to wear the correct clothing, including a PE t-shirt with the school logo on.

## **Staffing for 2020 - 2021**

Today your child was told the **adults who will be working in their phase next year.**

With the exception of Reception at St John's & St Peter's CE Academy two year groups work as a phase. For example, Year Three and Year Four work in an open plan classroom and are known as Lower Key Stage Two (LKS2). The staff in the phase work with both year groups and there is not a specific year three teacher or a specific year four teacher.

Each phase is made up of two teachers, one Higher Level Teaching Assistant and a number of Teaching Assistants. Each member of the team is equally important in ensuring that your child is happy and successful in school.

I am really proud of the staff who work at All Saints Multi Academy Trust Birmingham and the dedication and enthusiasm they bring in giving the children so many different opportunities. They go above and beyond in all areas of their work, not just the staff who work directly with the children in the classrooms but all our support staff.

Deploying the staff each year is a complicated task as we have to ensure that we meet the needs of all our pupils using the experience and expertise of each member of staff. I have included the staffing list for both schools and you will see that a number of staff are transferring from one school to another. They are not leaving us as we are all part of the All Saints family.
