EYFS

This week the children have enjoyed reading the Three Little Pigs story and acting it out. Ask them to tell you what happens in the story.



Next week we will be carrying on learning about our five senses topic and we will be learning about our sense of touch. KS1

The children have had another brilliant week at school. We have continued painting our new SEL benches, which will be used outside on the playground, as well as starting a new science topic about animals.

We have continued with our Animal Antics Science topic in the afternoon and have been learning about animal classification and looking at animal behaviour. The Children will compare their pets to wild animals and will have to observe what animals we see in our local area.


